“The 2025 Pinot Meunier leads with pink flowers and strawberry tops, cherry pips and crushed oystershells. I like the salinity of Pinot Meunier when done right; it has an ethereal, rose petal quality alongside febrile-feeling tannins and a delicate, lacy shape. Here, the wine is all of that, with tension and beauty in abundance. It's a lovely, lovely wine. It was made with fully destemmed fruit and matured for six to eight months in large-format oak, the majority of which is seasoned. 13% alcohol, sealed under screw cap. Drink 2026 - 2036.” (Mar, 2026)

“Light ruby red colour with a touch of purple at the rim. Raspberry and bramble aromatics. Raspberry, rosemary and beetroot leaf on the palate, zippy acidity keeps it fresh with a hint of polished lift. Decent length and drive, built around acidity rather than tannins, and it will suit drinking with a bit of chill.” (Jan, 2026)
